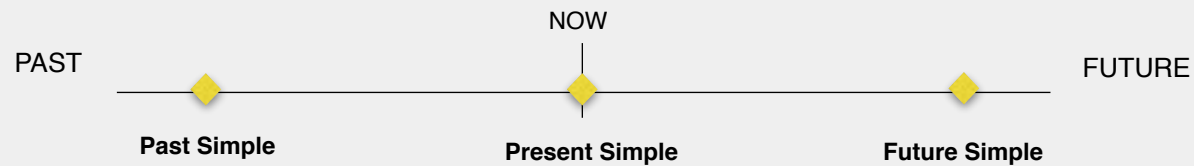
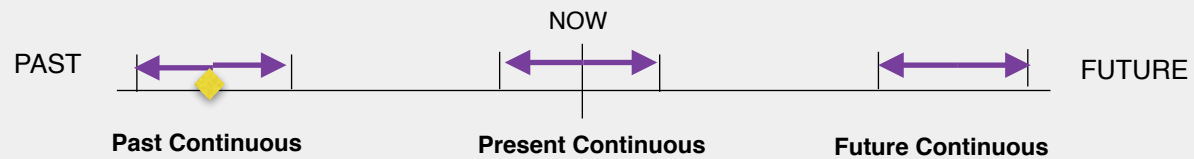


## Verb Tenses Chart: Time Lines

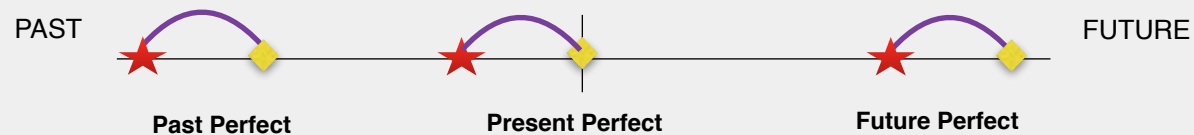
**Simple Tenses:** We use simple tenses whenever we talk about a **point** in time, e.g. a fact.



**Continuous Tenses:** We use continuous tenses whenever we talk about a **length of time**, e.g. an ongoing action.



**Perfect Tenses:** We use perfect tenses whenever we talk about **a point in time** before another **point in time**, e.g. 'I have lost my keys.'



**Perfect Continuous Tenses:** Perfect continuous tenses are used whenever we are talking about a **length of time** up to a point in time.
